

## Mazda3.0 installation Guide



Start by opening the glove box and removing the trim but lifting from the middle to the left and the last part to come out is the far right against the door.



Remove the 4 screws holding in the vents and stock head unit.



Pull the head unit out and remove the factory wire harness from the radio.



Your dash should now look like this.



Take out the cupholder starting from the back side.

Remove the 2 screws to pull the ash tray out.

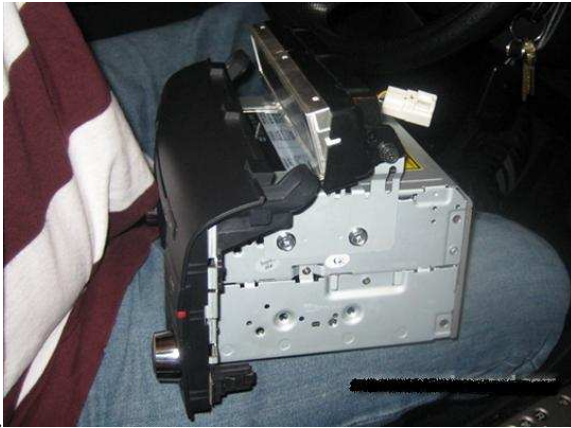
Take out the part shown in the picture. You'll put the Bluetooth receiver in this place because there is not too much space in the top section.

Connect the Bluetooth receiver with the device. This connection is very important because you'll be able to get the little LCD working also. Join CAN+ (device) with cable with CAN+ (Bluetooth receiver) and the CAN- (device) with CAN- (Bluetooth receiver). If not working, make a crossover: CAN- to CAN+ and CAN + to CAN-. It should work.

Add the brackets in the device for both sides and put together the little LCD with the new device.

before introducing the device, make sure everything is working correctly, when its working properly, fix all the cables in the back part, then you can put the device in from both sides at the same time.
